The Basilica of the Holy Rosary is one of the oldest Christian churches in the town Bandel at Hooghly, West Bengal, India. Founded in 1599. It is one of the most prominent historical churches in West Bengal as well as in India.

Hangseswari temple is a Hindu ratna temple located in the town Bansberia at Hooghly, West Bengal, India. In December 1799, Raja Nrisinhadeb Roy Mahasay laid the foundation stone of this temple. Hangseswari, a form of Maa adi parashakti jagatjanani dakshina kali in Hindu mythology.

Imambara is a Shia Muslim congregation hall and mosque in Hooghly, West Bengal India. The construction of the building was started by Muhammad Mohsin in 1841 and completed in 1861. The building is a two storied structure, with a tall clock tower over the entrance gate.

Objectives of the educational excursion

1. To explore the history of Hindu mythology.
2. To know the artistic creation of Muslim construction.
3. Explore different culture of different religion.
4. Interaction between different students.
