PROGRAM SPECIFIC OUTCOMES

The Economics(H) course will help develop the following attributes, qualities and skills among students:

The course acquaints the students with collection, organization, tabulation and analysis of empirical data. This program teaches students to use calculus, linear programming, linear algebra, game theory etc. In judging economic theories.

This course equips the student with skills to analyse problems, formulate a hypothesis, evaluate and validate results and draw reasonable conclusions thereof. It also prepares and motivates students for research studies in Economics especially by developing questionnaires and collecting primary data through field surveys. This is supplemented by the provision of knowledge of a wide range of econometric techniques using excel or R or stata like other statistical softwares. The course also makes students aware about how to use different websites like data.worldbank.org, www.rbi.org.in, www.dea.gov.in, www.mospi.gov.in etc. for secondary data collection. This course provides a foundation in applied econometric analysis and develops skills required for empirical research in economics.
