INITIATIVES TO IMPLEMENT NEP (2020) IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY

The syllabi of both Major and Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC) of Philosophy have been implemented from the Academic Session of 2023. The syllabi, framed by the Undergraduate Board of Studies in Philosophy of Calcutta University following the guidelines of UGC, aims to educate the students with a modern outlook of the subject. Different facets of modern Philosophical Ethics, viz, Professional and Business Ethics, are to be dealt, with a view of making rational and good social human beings. Moreover, the job-oriented internship programmes under NEP will prepare the students more eligible for getting livelihood, after the college studies are over.

INTRODUCING MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH

Philosophy as the Major Course is taught under the division of Humanities and the students, who have passed the Higher Secondary (under 10+2 curriculum) with Philosophy, subject is given the highest preference during admission. However, in accordance with the Undergraduate Board of Studies of University of Calcutta, if a candidate had not studied Philosophy as a subject in the previous qualifying examination, then Psychology/Sociology/Political Science/Education/Mathematics is treated as a related subject.

FLEXIBLE CURRICULUM

Under NEP, a student in our college can opt for Philosophy as a subject of MDC, debarring to take Bengali/English/Hindi/Psychology/Economics as the latter subjects fall into the same division as decided by the college authority due to the constraint of classes allotment in the routine.

USE OF TECHNOLOGY

We usually follow the chalk-and talk method. Apart from this, the departmental faculty are also used to give Power-Point deliberations in cases of intricacies of the subject matters. We also provide to the students' hand-written class notes, prepared from different reference books. In cases of emergency, mainly during the holidays, some online classes are taken to clarify the students queries, using computers.

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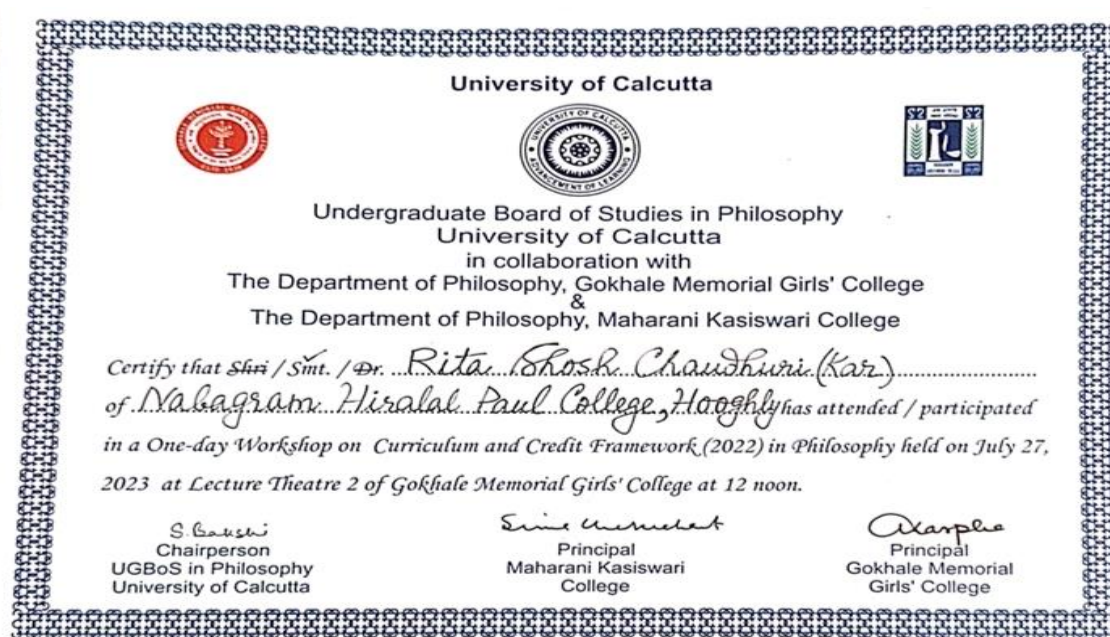
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TEACHERS PARTICIPATION
