- ❖ **Research Competence:** Graduates should be capable of conducting independent research, including data collection, analysis, and synthesis, leading to informed conclusions.
- ❖ **Effective Communication:** Graduates should excel in written and oral communication, allowing them to convey political ideas and arguments clearly and persuasively.
- ❖ **Ethical and Values-Based Decision Making:** Graduates should be aware of ethical considerations in political decision-making and demonstrate an understanding of the values that underpin political processes.
- ❖ **Global Perspective:** The Programme provides an introduction to the issues in Foreign Policy, Indian and World Constitutions, Comparative Politics, International Relations, Indian Politics, Political Theory, Public Administration. The students of the department are also taught special papers on Human Rights, legal issues and the legal system of India, along with papers on research methods and dimensions of research. Graduates should recognize the interconnectedness of global politics and exhibit awareness of international issues, diplomacy, and global governance.
- ❖ **Civic Engagement and Responsibility:** Graduates should be prepared to engage in civic and political activities, contributing positively to their communities and society.
- ❖ **Cultural Competence:** Understand the cultural and social factors that influence political behavior and decision-making.
- ❖ **Interdisciplinary Competence:** Graduates should be able to draw insights from related fields such as economics, sociology, and law, enhancing their ability to analyze complex political phenomena.
